RATING/GRADE CONVERSION

“How is CREW graded?”

In the case studies, students earn proficiency ratings based on the CREW rubric through self-evaluation and evaluation by the CREW Leader. The total rating will be converted to a grade at the end of the course, so what you will see on the first semester report card is the grade conversion of your student’s current rating. Your student’s final proficiency rating/grade will represent the student’s growth based on the rubric through the whole year. It will not be an average of first semester and second semester grade.
