



Dear Parent/Guardian:

Our records indicate your student has failed a class with a final yearly grade between 50 and 59 and has the opportunity to participate in our credit recovery program June 6th – 8th at no charge. Students will learn and test through an online computer program called Edgenuity to master missed content and earn credit. Credit recovery is not a summer school program. *Courses offered are listed on page 2.*

Once your student has completed the requirements for credit recovery, he or she will receive a 60 for a final grade, as well as the associated credit for the course. If a student does not complete the requirements, the original final failing grade will remain. Students must earn an English and Math credit each year to meet promotion requirements. If promotion requirements are not met, he or she will be retained in their current grade.

Promotion requirements to be a sophomore:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 5 credits of which one must be English and one Math
Promotion requirements to be a junior	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 11 credits of which two must be English and two must be Math
Promotion requirements to be a senior:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 16 credits with at least two English and at least two math ● Be enrolled in all courses to complete the 24 credits needed for the SC High School Diploma

Students may recover one or two courses through the credit recovery program at RBHS. If a student has failed more than three classes and has qualified for credit recovery, the student can recover two classes through RBHS. The credit recovery labs will be offered on our campus at the times listed below.

<p><u>CREDIT RECOVERY DATES</u> Underclassmen Session: (24 Hours) (Juniors, Sophomores and Freshmen) Students MUST be present on campus each day for the entire time.</p>
<p>June 6th (Tuesday): 8:00a.m. to 3:00p.m. (8 hours) June 7th (Wednesday): 8:00a.m. to 3:00p.m. (8 hours) June 8th (Thursday): 8:00a.m. to 3:00p.m. (8 hours) Lunch Hour: 11:00a.m. to 12:00p.m. Lunch is not provided by the school</p> <p>Students may bring their own lunch or may leave campus for food during the lunch hour. Students must be back to their testing room by 12:00pm. The 24 hours listed above are mandatory to receive credit.</p>

Credit Recovery is self-paced through a computer program and your student may need additional time to complete the course. Students have a final completion date of July 17th at 12:00pm. Students who need to work outside of the three dates at River Bluff will need to access the credit recovery program (website) on their own. The credit recovery program must be 100% complete with a final grade of 60% or higher in order for a final grade 60 to replace the original failing grade of the course.
